# The concept of data library and its opportunities

Data: existing information or knowledge that is represented or coded in some form suitable for better usage or processing.

VS

Data: meaningful information in the form of <u>images</u> like (aerial) photos, films and recorded testimonies, <u>documents</u> like archivalia and maps, <u>objects</u>, and <u>inventories</u>.



Practically: digital collections of information that we can make accessible and share through platforms like apps and websites.

VS

Theoretically: a concept of inventarising, collecting, selecting, sharing and making accessible of meaningful data (information).

## **Opportunities:**

- More information available for research, protection, exhibitions
- Online marketplace
- Better policy making, e.g. spatial planning and aera development







#### Drawbacks:

- Inventory: more information about objects and sites can give way to illegal activities en tresspassing.
- Inventory: overwhelming amount of objects and levels of description
- Dichotomy amateur-professional



## **Conclusion:**

- The concept of data library is promising, but comprehensive and should be discussed thouroughly
- Without the cooperation and knowledge of amateurs, the concept of data library is doomed to fail.
